About one year ago, HPAI was detected in Oregon in a backyard flock and captive falcon. In the months that followed HPAI was detected in 15 states, devastating the poultry industry in those states.



On December 4, 2015, USDA reported that H5 avian influenza was found in genetic material collected from a wild mallard duck tested in Morrow County, Oregon. This is confirmation that what the poultry disease experts have been saying all along is correct... that it is likely that avian influenza will be circulating in wild birds when they migrate south. The risk is real.

During 2015, it became evident that there was an urgent need to improve biosecurity practices. A tremendous amount of work has gone into preparing for and preventing avian influenza over the past year.
