

January 2016 Update: HPAI has been detected in southern Indiana.

The recent discovery of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza disease in a southern Indiana turkey flock serves as a sober reminder to not become complacent on your farm. AI can strike at any time during this cold season.

Now is the time to review **ALL** of your farm's biosecurity program. It only takes one biosecurity breakdown to introduce avian influenza into your flocks.

Entering your poultry house safely is the #1 thing you can do to be **ALL IN** and **PROTECT YOUR FARM**.

Every person who enters your poultry houses must follow the same biosecurity steps, and every piece of equipment or other item brought into your houses must be properly disinfected.

Any entry into your poultry houses by any person has the potential to infect your flock.

ALL IN means **EVERYBODY**. Please make sure your workers, family and anyone entering your poultry houses are **ALL IN** and **FOLLOWING THROUGH** on your farm's biosecurity program.
